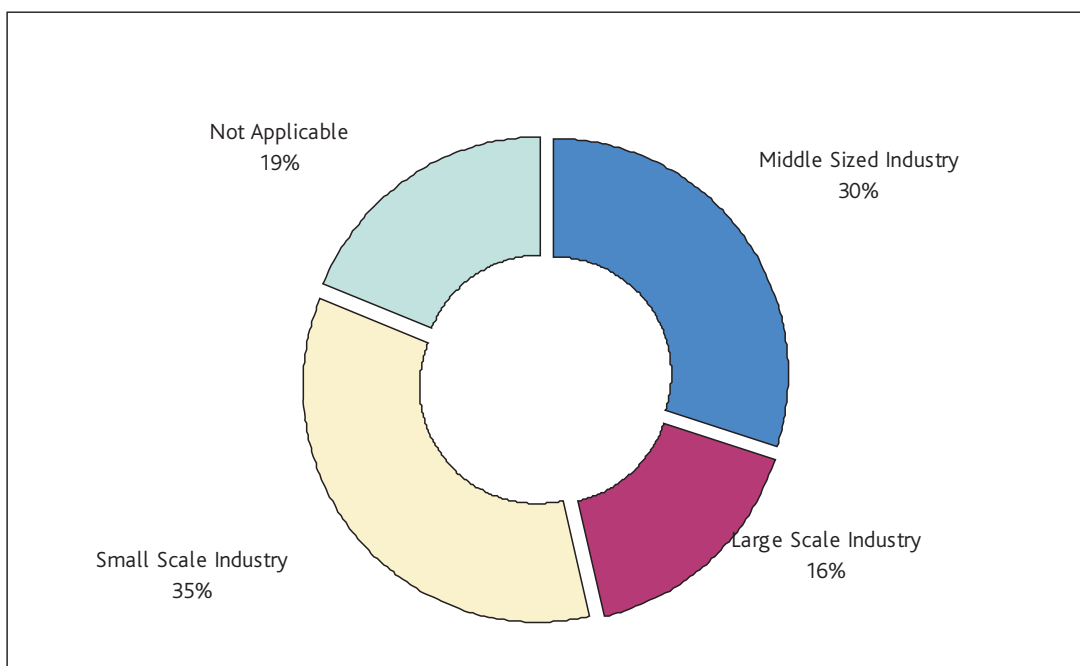

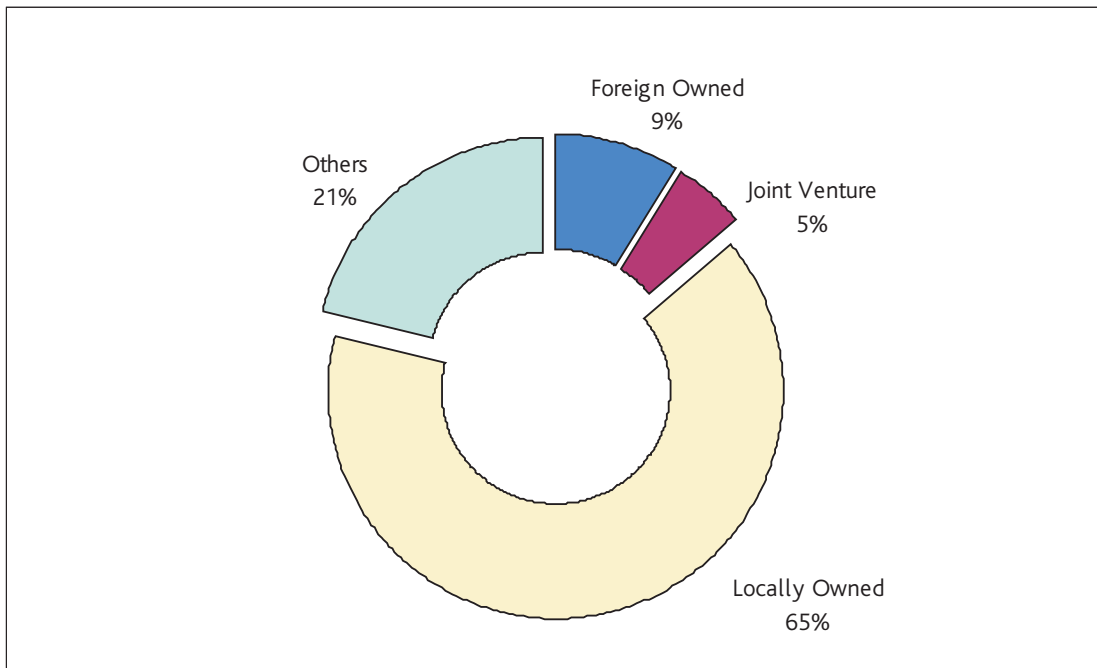

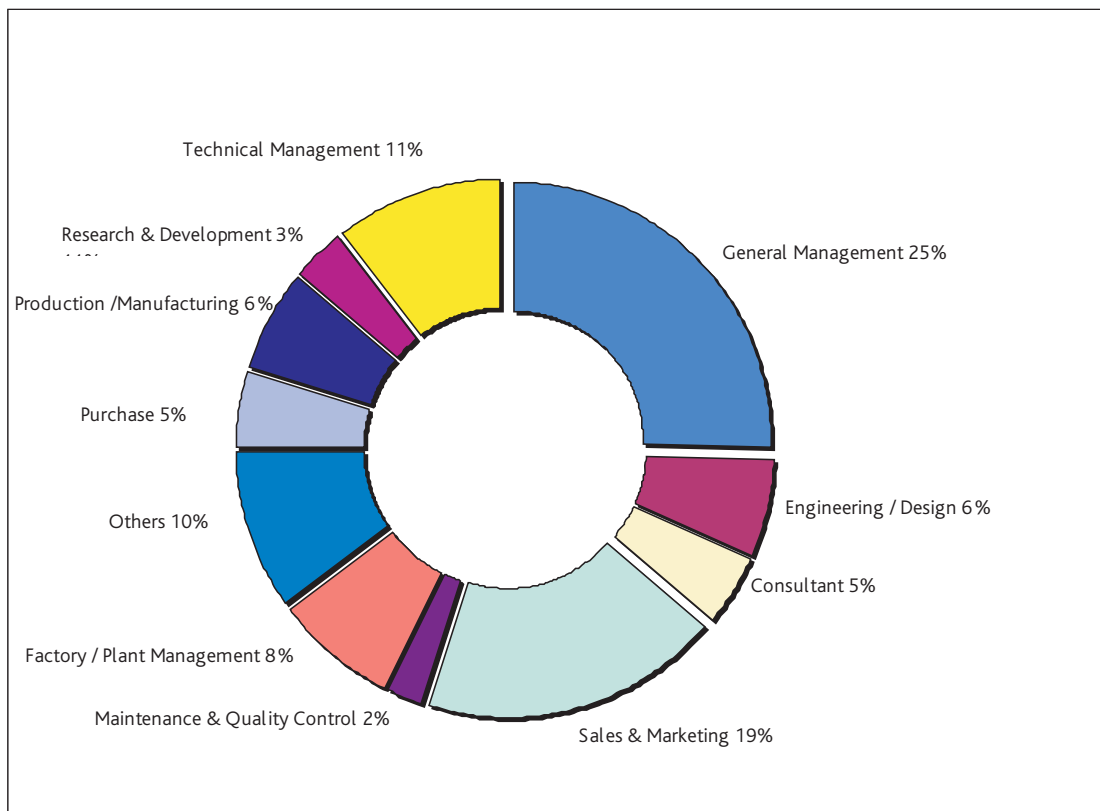
1. Scale of Companies



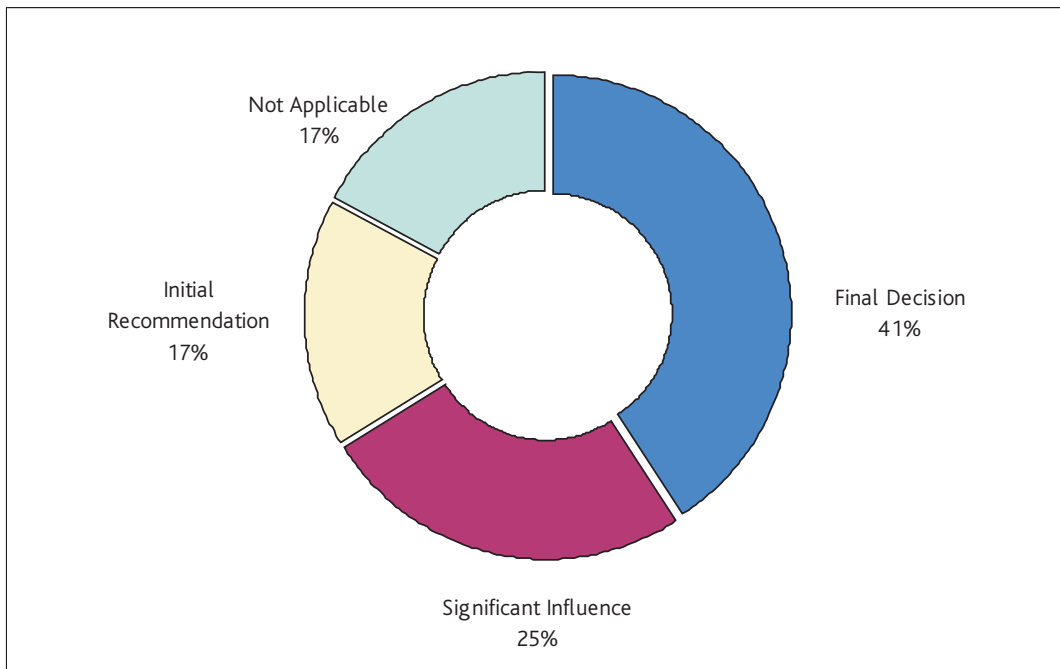

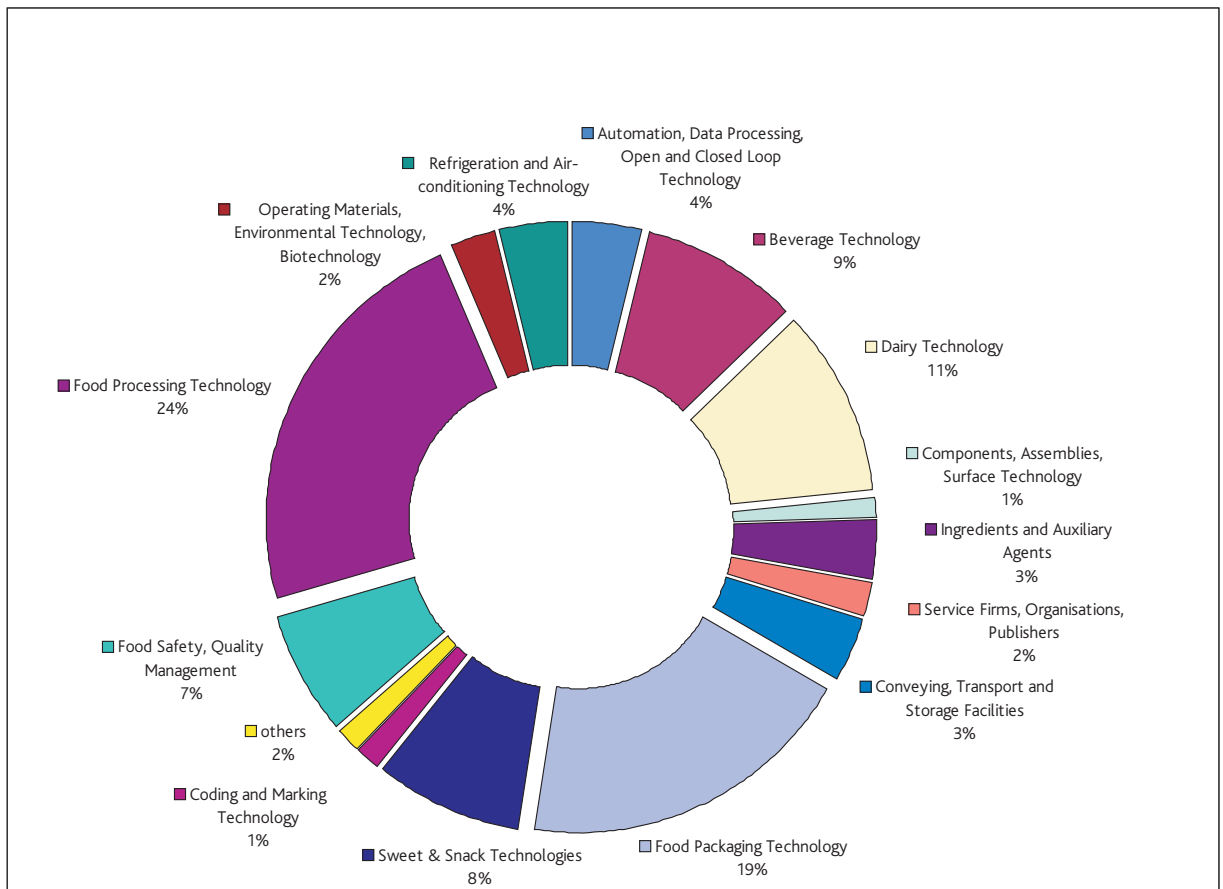

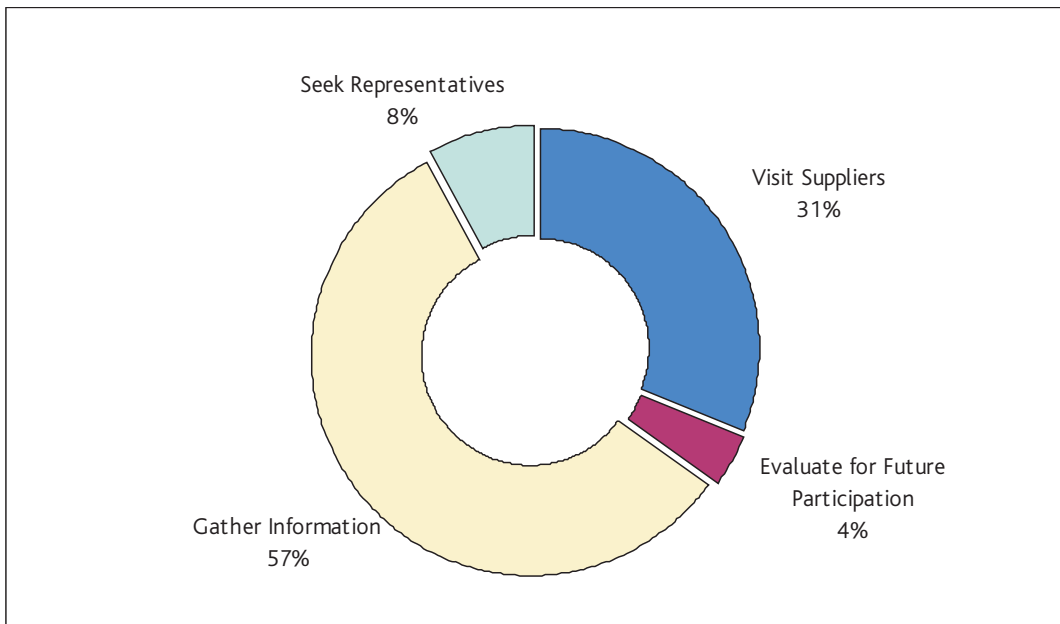

PRESS RELEASE - Final Report on International FoodTec India 2009

International FoodTec India strengthens its position as sector's leading Indian trade fair

The 6th edition of International FoodTec India, which ran from 17th to 19th September 2009 in the financial capital of India, Mumbai closed with good results. Around 5,088 trade visitors from 20 countries came to this three-day event to find out about the product range on offer from 172 exhibiting companies from 21 countries. In connection with the incorporated trade fairs Dairy Universe India and Sweet & Snack Factory India, International FoodTec India provided a comprehensive overview of all areas of food and beverage technology. "International FoodTec India which has established itself as the leading trade fair for the food and beverage processing and packaging industry. Based on the success of its earlier shows it has confirmed its position once again with the success of this edition as well," says Ashwani Pande, Managing Director of Koelnmesse YA Tradefair.

From a total of 172 suppliers at International FoodTec India, who were represented in Hall 5 of the Bombay Exhibition Center in Mumbai, 88 came from India and the remaining 84 suppliers from 20 countries outside of India. The strongest contingents included Italy with 17 suppliers, followed by Germany with 15 and France with 11 companies. Among other nationally and internationally renowned companies that presented their spectrum of products and services were Heat & Control, GEA, Kanchan Metals, Shanghai Precise, Illies Engineering, Nichrome India, E.C. Packtech, Associated Capsules Group, Dynatech Marketing, Saurabh Flexipack, Kiron Hydraulic Needs, Standard Machinery, and Menon Technical Services, etc. The trade visitors were mainly from India, although around 120 international buyers were also registered from 19 countries.

Returns in 2010 with two concurrent trade fairs

From 2010, International FoodTec India will be organized concurrent to **IndiaPack**, International Packaging Exhibition and Conference and **Asia Coat+Ink Show**, Asia's exclusive show of Printing Inks and Coatings. By bringing together these three shows, both exhibitors and visitors can make the most out of the synergy created between these shows which covers the entire value chain of food and beverage processing industry.
